We remember fondly Fred W. Kelley, Jr. He was born on April 16, 1934 in Bonnie, IL, to Frederick Wilford Kelley, Sr. and Edna Gertrude (Shaffer) Kelley. Over the years, Fred served as a Sergeant in the United States Army, worked for the railroad, and was an officer with the Sanford Police Dept. Following his years there, he rose to Lt. in the Juvenile Division of the Seminole County Sheriff's Dept. After leaving the Sheriff's Dept., he went into private security. He married Linda L. Petersen on October 18, 1975. He is remembered for his many years spent in the martial arts disciplines. Fred owned Kelley's Martial Arts, where he taught Judo, Karate and Kobudo with his wife Linda. Fred died on Sept. 14, 2004 at Lucerne Medical Center.
